

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING TUESDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2001

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a Special Called Meeting on Tuesday, October 9, 2001 at the Onion Creek Country Club Clubhouse, located at 2510 Onion Creek Parkway, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Pro Tem Goodman called the meeting to order at 6:43 p.m.

Public hearing on full purpose annexation of the Onion Creek municipal annexation plan area (approximately 1222 acres located on the east side of IH-35 at the Onion Creek Parkway/IH 35 intersection.)
