

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING CANVASSING THE VOTES FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2001

The City Council of Austin, Texas, convened in a Special Called meeting on Friday, November 9, 2001 at 1:30 p.m. in Room 120 of the Municipal Building, 124 W. 8<sup>th</sup> Street, Austin, Texas.

Mayor Watson called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

1. To canvass results of the City Council Special Municipal Election of November 6, 2001. Resolution No. 011109-01 was approved on Mayor Pro Tem Goodman's motion, Council Member Slusher's second by a 4-0 vote. Council Members Alvarez, Griffith and Wynn were absent.
