

MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL

CITY OF AUSTIN, TEXAS

Regular Meeting

June 1, 1944
10:40 A.M.

Council Chamber, City Hall

The meeting was called to order, with Mayor Miller presiding.

Roll call

Present: Councilmen Alford, Bartholomew, Gillis, Mayor Miller - 4
Absent : Councilman Wolf - 1

Present also: Walter E. Seaholm, Acting City Manager; J. E. Motheral, City Engineer; J. M. Patterson, Acting City Attorney; and R. D. Thorp, Chief of Police.

The minutes of the Regular Meeting of May 25, 1944, were read, and upon motion of Councilman Alford were adopted as read by the following vote:

The REVEREND W. M. ANDERSON, colored, came before the Council and requested permission to move the Pilgrims Home Baptist Church building located at 902 West 25th Street to another location; and submitted an offer to sell the City the lot on which said building is now located.

It was the sense of the meeting that the offer to sell the City the lot in question be declined; and that the matter of moving the church building be referred to the City Engineer for attention.

The following report of the Board of Adjustment on the change in zoning of the premises at 1502 Lavaca Street was received:

The following is a copy of a resolution which was passed by the Board of Adjustment at a meeting on May 30, 1944:

R E S O L U T I O N .

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Austin, pursuant to the terms of Section 31 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Austin, has referred to the Zoning Board of Adjustment for its consideration a petition of Dr. Robt. W. Shipp requesting a change in the Use designation of the following property:

A part of Lot 5, Block 38, of the Original City of Austin, Texas, being No. 1502 Lavaca Street, portions of an existing building occupied by a commercial use;

from "C-1" Commercial District to "C-2" Commercial District; and

WHEREAS, on March 6, 1944, the above owner filed an appeal with the Board of Adjustment for a variation of the Zoning Ordinance to permit a liquor store to be installed in a portion of the above building, which appeal was withdrawn on motion of the Board that it was without jurisdiction under the law to grant such a variation; and

WHEREAS, the owner subsequently filed an application with the City Council for a change in the zoning classification in this said portion of the said premises which was referred to the Board for consideration and recommendation; and whereupon the Board passed a resolution and submitted the same to the Council recommending against this change; and

WHEREAS, thereafter upon notice of a public hearing, the Council did change the zoning classification of this portion of the building, contrary to the recommendations of the Board, at a regular meeting of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, this portion of the building now appears on the zoning maps of the City of Austin as a spot zone which is not being used for the purpose appealed for as acknowledged by the owner in this application; and

WHEREAS, this second application is for a change of another portion of the same building for the same purposes as stated in the original application, which portion is now occupied by a legal commercial use; and

WHEREAS, the Board again carefully considered this application in connection with its effect on the property, conformance with the terms of the Ordinance, and relation to a comprehensive zoning plan for the City of Austin; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems that all of the conditions and circumstances and reasons set out in the original resolution recommending against the former change apply equally to the present application; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT:

THAT the change of this specific portion of the property

requested in the application be not recommended to the City Council; and that the City Council be urged to deny the application for the following principal reasons:

(1) THAT the Board desires to again emphasize the fact that this application is for a change of only a portion of a lot of record and a part of the building, which does not properly define the boundaries of the changed use area in accordance with the requirements of the Ordinance, which stipulates that the boundaries of zoning districts shall be either streets, alleys or property lines;

(2) THAT this change will create another spot zone unrelated to any general zoning plan for this District, or in answer to any public demand or change in trend of land use in this area;

(3) THAT, in general, spot zoning for any purpose is contrary to the purpose and spirit of the Ordinance, and, if continuously indulged in, will eventually break down the Zoning Ordinance, and basically is a grant of special privilege to a property owner as against the interests of the public under the philosophy of the Zoning law;

(4) THAT in this particular case the premises are now legally occupied and the present tenant would have to be evicted for the sole purpose of making available the premises for a new tenant, presumably for an increase in rent, which financial consideration has not been declared to be a valid cause for zoning changes by the courts of the land;

(5) THAT it is inconceivable to assign any measure of hardship on the owner should this appeal be denied inasmuch as the owner is not dependent upon the rental of this property for this purpose for his economic security;

(6) THAT after a long period of study for the control of the liquor traffic through the Zoning Ordinance, the City Council established a "C-1" District, which permits the sale of wine and beer in approved cafes and restaurants, in addition to the existing "C-2" District, in which liquors of all types may be sold to the public, and Lavaca Street after due public notice and hearing was zoned as a "C-1" Commercial District, making it possible for the cafes and restaurants located thereon to serve wine and beer with their meals, but excluding spirituous liquors, at which time all property owners had ample opportunity to be heard concerning their own properties;

(7) THAT the granting of this appeal would let down the bars completely and permit the establishment of open saloons, package stores and the sale of spirituous liquors to the public in these particular spots while prohibiting this privilege to the other property owners in this zone.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT:

THAT inasmuch as the original spot zone granted by the Council

in the first portion of the building is not now occupied for the purpose applied for, the Council is urged to rescind its former action and place this portion of the building back into the "C-1" District in harmony of the use classification of the property on Lavaca Street.

Pursuant to published notice thereof, this being the day and the hour for the public hearing on the proposal of the City Council to amend the Zoning Ordinance in the following particulars, to-wit:

To amend Subsection (e) of Section 18 of that certain ordinance passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Austin, Texas, July 17, 1941, being a general revision of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Austin, which ordinance is recorded in Book "L", pages 152-174, of the Ordinance Records of the City of Austin, so as to change the last two words "as required" to "of three (3) feet."

To amend Subsection (a) of Section 19 of that certain ordinance passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Austin, Texas, July 17, 1941, being a general revision of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Austin, which ordinance is recorded in Book "L", pages 152-174, of the Ordinance Records of the City of Austin, so as to change the words "forty feet", in the last line to "forty per cent (40%)."

To amend the USE designation of the following described property so as to change same from "C-1" Commercial District to "C-2" Commercial District: A portion of Lot 5, Block 38, Original City, known as 1502 Lavaca Street, in the City of Austin, Texas;

the Mayor thereupon announced the hearing open.

The following persons were then heard for and against the proposed change in the USE designation of the property known as 1502 Lavaca Street:

DR. ROBT. W. SHIPP, proponent, represented also by his agent, J. E. HARRISON, appeared in support of the proposed change.

MRS. J. E. LINDEMAN, represented by MRS. CARRIE TODD and J. O. GARRETT; and S. W. MATHIS appeared and protested the proposed change.

Written requests of A. D. BOLM and R. G. MUELLER that the entire block on Lavaca Street between 15th and 16th Streets be changed instead, were received.

There being no other objectors desiring to be heard; and all those present having been given a fair and impartial hearing, the hearing was thereupon closed.

There being no objectors present to be heard on the proposed change in the text of the Zoning Ordinance, this hearing was also thereupon closed.

Councilman Alford then introduced the following ordinance:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THAT CERTAIN ORDINANCE PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN, TEXAS, JULY 17, 1941, AND RECORDED IN ORDINANCE BOOK "L", PAGES 152-174, INCLUSIVE, OF THE ORDINANCE RECORDS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN, WHICH ORDINANCE WAS AMENDATORY OF THAT CERTAIN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ZONING REGULATIONS AND DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL APRIL 23, 1931, AND RECORDED IN ORDINANCE BOOK "I", PAGES 301-318, BOTH INCLUSIVE, OF THE ORDINANCE RECORDS OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN; THE AMENDATORY ORDINANCE HEREBY ENACTED CHANGING THE USE DESIGNATION FROM "C-1" COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO "C-2" COMMERCIAL DISTRICT OF A PORTION OF LOT 5, BLOCK 38, ORIGINAL CITY, KNOWN AS 1502 LAVACA STREET IN THE CITY OF AUSTIN, TEXAS; AND ORDERING A DELINEATION OF THE OFFICIAL USE MAP, SO AS TO SHOW THE CHANGES HEREBY ORDERED; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THOMPSON, TRUSTEE, INTERNATIONAL-GREAT NORTHERN RAILROAD COMPANY, DEBTOR, HIS SUCCESSORS, ASSIGNS, LESSEES, LICENSEES, AND INVITEES, THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE, AND FRANCHISE OF CONSTRUCTING, MAINTAINING, AND OPERATING A CERTAIN RAILROAD SPUR TRACK IN AND ALONG WEST FOURTH STREET, BETWEEN RIO GRANDE STREET AND NUECES STREET, ADJACENT TO THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY OF BLOCK FORTY-SEVEN IN THE CITY OF AUSTIN, TRAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS; AND PRESCRIBING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SUCH RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND FRANCHISE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin:

THAT the City Assessor and Collector of Taxes be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to charge off and strike from the delinquent rolls the various items of taxes as follows:

LIST OF ASSESSMENTS OF AUTOMOBILES, MERCHANDISE, AND MISCELLANEOUS PERSONAL PROPERTY FOR PAST YEARS WHICH THE CITY COUNCIL, BY RESOLUTION ATTACHED HERETO, HAS AUTHORIZED TO BE CHARGED OFF BECAUSE SAME ARE DEEMED TO BE UNCOLLECTABLE DUE TO THE FACT THAT THE PROPERTY OR THE OWNER THEREOF, OR BOTH, CANNOT BE LOCATED.
