## (RESOLUTION)

WHEREAS, the City of Austin taxes for the years 1931 through 1941 were assessed in the name of Dr. G. F. Eckhardt on personal property in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, said taxes for said years being in the amount of \$53.28, and for non-payment of same at maturity, penalty in the sum of \$2.67 has been assessed, and interest in the amount of \$25.53 has accrued, making the total amount of taxes, penalty and interest due \$81.48; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Austin deems it just and equitable to remit said penalty in the sum of \$2.67 and one-half of the interest in the sum of \$12.76; therefore

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Austin deems it just and equitable to remit said penalty in the sum of \$27.30 and one-half of the interest in the sum of \$89.23; therefore.
