charged thom to Lot 6, making a total valuation of the improvements, 44,480.00, but the records showing such valuations as fixed by said experts and by which the Assessor and Collector completed his tax rolls show values as follows: Lot 6, 44,480.00, the total value on all lots; and on Lots 7 and 8, 2,745.00, or a total valuation of 7,225.00; and

WHEREAS, it appears from said records that Mr. Heflybower is charged with a double valuation on Lots 7 and 8, or \$2,745.00 more than he should be charged with,

Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

That the Assessor and Collector be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to correct said error on his rolls and to take credit for taxes on \$2,745.00, the erroneous valuation.

The above resolution was adopted by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Copeland, Eyres, Haynes and Searight, 5; nayes, none. The Council then recessed.
