REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL:

Austin, Texas, March 13, 1924.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor. Roll call showed the following members present: Mayor Yett, Councilmen Haynes, Nolen and Searight, 4; absent, Councilman Avery.

The petition of J. F. Pike and others presented by Rev. Joshua Phipps, asking that the City Council build a bridge on East 13th Street, was read and ordered filed.

The Minutes of the last meetings were read and Councilman Haynes moved that same be adopted. Motion prevailed by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Haynes, Nolen and Searight, 4; naves, none, Councilman Avery absent.

The communication of Sam Sparks, in the matter of regulating domino halls in the City, was read and ordered filed.

The committee report on the application of Gargill Sign Company to erect an electric sign at 6th and Neches Streets was read and Councilman Searight moved that same be granted as recommended by the Safety Committee. Motion prevailed by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Haynes, Nolen and Searight, 4; naves, none, Councilman Avery absent.

The report of the Safety Committee upon the application of Lin Gower, asking for permission to locate a gasoline filling station at 803 East 23rd Street was read and Councilman Searight moved that same be granted as recommended by the Safety Committee. Motion prevailed by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Haynes, Nolen and Searight, 4; naves, none, Councilman Avery absent.

Councilman Haynes introduced the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board of Equalization, per statement herewith, on the protest of Mr. Taylor Sanders against the increase made by them in the valuation of a Studebaker roadster from \$300.00 as rendered by him for taxes of 1923 to \$800.00, recommend that the valuation placed by them be reduced to \$400.00,

Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

That the Assessor and Collector be and he is hereby instructed to change the assessment on his rolls accordingly and take credit for \$400.00, amount of reduction.

The above resolution was adopted by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Haynes, Nolen and Searight, 4; naves, none, Councilman Avery absent.

Councilman Nolen nominated Arthur E. Biard and John A. Simpson as special policemen. Nominations were confirmed by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Haynes and Searight, 3; naves, none, Councilman Avery absent, and Councilman Nolen present but not voting.

The monthly report of R. E. Nitschke, City Sexton, was read and ordered filed.

Councilman Nolen introduced the following resolution:

WHEREAS, in each of the following named and numbered cases the defendant was fined in the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) and costs, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Eleven Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$11.80); and

WHEREAS, each of said defendants has paid the fine imposed, but the costs in each case has not yet been collected because the City Council for reasons to it deemed sufficient had determined to remit said costs,
