The Council was called to order by the Mayor. Roll call showed the following members present: Mayor Yett, Councilmen Avery, and Searight, 3; absent, Councilmen Haynes and Nolen.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and Councilman Avery moved that same be adopted. Motion prevailed by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Avery and Searight, 3; nays, none, Councilmen Haynes and Nolen absent.

The communication of the Kiwanis Club was read and Councilman Avery moved that same be referred to the City Attorney with instructions to prepare draft of ordinance and submit same to the City Council. Motion prevailed by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Avery and Searight, 3; nays, none, Councilmen Haynes and Nolen absent.

The monthly reports of R. E. Nitschke, City Sexton, and Mrs. R. C. Walker, Pure Food Inspector, were read and ordered filed.

The petition of J. E. McClellan and others was read and ordered filed.

The certificate of Joe Hornsby, City Clerk, certifying the official returns of an election held on August 9th, 1924, wherein twenty-two amendments to the present City Charter were voted upon was read and Councilman Avery moved that said certificate be referred to the City Attorney, J. Bouldin Rector, for action and report back to the Council. Motion prevailed by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Avery and Searight, 3; nays, none, Councilmen Haynes and Nolen absent.


