

Regular meeting of the City Council: Austin, Texas, May 28th 1914.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor: Roll called :

Present Mayor Wooldridge, Councilmen Anthony, Bartholomew, Haynes & Powell 5

Absent none.

The minutes of the last regular and subsequent recessed meetings were read and adopted.

The Mayor laid before the Council the following resolution :

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin :

That the Treasurer of the City of Austin be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to transfer from the General fund of the City of Austin to the General Street fund of the City of Austin the five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) appropriated in the resolution of the City Council on the 21st day of May, 1914, appropriating to the general uses of the Street Department the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) out of the General Contingent fund , a copy of which resolution is attached hereto.
