

Regular meeting of the City Council: Austin, Texas, October 15th 1914.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor: Roll called:

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and adopted :

Reports of City Officers:

The Mayor laid before the Council the reports of the City Sexton, Supt Water & Light Plant & the Inspector Hospital building, which were read and ordered filed:

Councilman Bartholomew offered the following resolution :

Whereas, 16th street from Comal to Concho streets in this City are entirely included in the extension to the East of Oakwood Cemetery and is intended to be incorporated by the City in the said Annex,

Now, therefore,

Resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin :

That 16th street from Comal to Concho streets in this City be and the same is hereby declared vacated and closed to traffic, vehicular and otherwise.
