.Regular meeting of the City Council: Austin, Texas, July 16th 1914

The Council was called to order by the Mayor: Roll called :

Unfinished business:

The Mayor laid before the Council a resolution directing the Supt of Streets and Public Improvements to advertise for bids and arrange for paving the aleys between Congress Avenue and Colorado street , from 7th to 10th street and the alleys between Congress Avenue and Braxos street from 7th to 10th street with concrete pavement in accordance with the specifications of the City Engineer attached to this resolution , which specifications are hereby adopted for the aforesaid alleys.
