That the sum of \$ 800.00, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Sanatary Sewer fund to pay for 4 a line of 6 inch sewer 1250 feet in lengal beginning at the intersection of 30th street, extending southward to 29th MXKK street, thence westward on 29th street to the alley between Guadelupe and Rio Grande streets, thence southward through said alley to a point 100 feet north of 28th street and including the construction of two manholes and a flush tank.
