Whereas, Lets 5 & 6,in Block 8, Outlets 32 & 33, Division "B" in Glenwood addition to the City of Austin, Texas, stands charged with taxes in the amount of \$11.15, on personal property for the year 1910, when said property was ewned .together with personal property, by one L P Piper; and

Whoreas, said L P piper defaulted in the payment of taxes an said personal preperty for the year 1918, and is still delinquent on said personal property taxes; and

Whoreas, the taxes upon said lets 5 & 6, Blook 8, Outlets 32 & 33, Dim "B" have been paid by subsequent ewners of the same , whe, hewever, strengly ebject to paying the personal property taxes charged against same for the

. .year 1910 and alloge ne knewledge of the existence of said personal preperty taxes,

New Therefore,

Be it reselved by the City Council of the City of Austin, Texas :

That in consideration of the law as we understand it to be and the extreme equity of the case , said Lets 5 & 6 in Block 8, Outlets 32 & 33, Division "B" in Glenwood addition in the City of Austin, Texas, are hereby relieved from the lien , if any, for the personal property taxes charged against same when they were the property of the said L P Piper.
