BY Alderman Crooker, An ordinance extending the time to complete one mile of railway track within the limits of the City of Austin, under an ordinance granting a right of way and other privileges over, along and on the streets and avenues of the City of Austin, Texas, originally in the name of Ralf W Carroll, or New York City, his associates and assigns, passed by the City Council of Austin, on the 4th day of June, A D 1905, and approved by the Mayor

of Astoria June 5th 1905, and under subsequent ordinance amending the same. The ordinance was read the first time, and on motion the rule was suspended and the ordinance placed on its second reading by the following vote :
