

Regular meeting of the City Council: Austin, Texas, November 30th 1915.

That in consideration of the very severe pecuniary loss sustained by J V Maery in the floods of April 22nd & 23rd, 1915, the sum of two dollars and forty seven cents (\$2.47) the same being the penalty owing upon his unpaid taxes for the year 1915, be and the same is hereby remitted ; it being understood that the said J V Maery will promptly pay the balance in full , principal and interest, of his taxes for the year 1915.
