 streets, same being taken from the fire plug at the SW
 corner 14th & Lavaca streets, assumed elevation 100
 Center of Lavaca Street 97.8 Grade unchanged
 East side of Lavaca Street 97.5 Rise 4'
 138 feet east of Lavaca Street 98.7 " 8'
 186 " " " " " 99.2 " 8'
 230 " " " " " 99.8 " 7'
 West line of Colorado Street 100.5 " 2'
 Grade at center of Colorado Street unchanged 101.2
 The resolution was read the first time
 On motion the Council adjourned 7
