The Minutes of the last session and adjournments were read and adopted.

Reports of City officers.

The Mayor laid before the Council the reports of the Assessor and Collector & the Matron of the Hospital for the Month of July 1910, which were read and ordered filed.

Unfinished business:

The Mayor laid before the Council a resolution appropriating the sum of \$770<sup>00</sup> for the purpose of purchasing property from land for street purposes a street 60 feet wide out of Cut Lot 8. D. 200. in the City of Austin, which was read the third time and passed by the following Vote: Mayor Woredridge, Councilmen Bartholomew, Gracy and Powell

Votes None.

The Mayor laid before the Council an ordinance to grant to Tom Gregory Company and Dr. W. W. Weare the right to construct, maintain and operate a railroad track upon and across certain streets in the City of Austin, subject to certain conditions and penalties.

The ordinance was read the second time and laid over. The Mayor laid before the Council an ordinance to amend an ordinance entitled an ordinance providing for the Pure Food Ordinance, passing first and for the sale of pure food stuffs within the City of Austin, providing for the issuance of permits for the sale of dairy products, providing for the issuance of permits for the sale of meats, fish and fowls; providing for the issuance of permits for the sale of fruits, vegetables and other goods; for the inspection and regulation of hotels, restaurants and boarding houses; providing for the promulgation of rules for the better health of the City of Austin; and providing penalties for the violation of such rules, and the provision of this ordinance.

The ordinance was read the third time and passed by the following Vote.

Gentlemen:

Complying with your instructions, I have made a survey of Pedernales Street from Sixth Street, South to the Colorado River. I have now attached hereto a sketch, showing data obtained. You will notice on this sketch a dotted line running up Pedernales Street throughout its entire length. This is an arbitrary line taken half way between the East lines of Quarto, 38<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> 24<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> the West lines of Quarto 29<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> 6<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> at right angles to the established centre line of East First Street.<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> From this arbitrary line distances to fences<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> states on each side of Pedernales Street are referred. The following is a summary of these distances and width of Pedernales Street.

At the North line of Sixth Street, pipe on West side 36<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet from line, stake on East 21<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet from line, total width of street 57<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet.

At the South line of Sixth Street is a fence corner 38<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet West,<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> nothing on the East.

At the North line of Fifth Street the fence on the West is 28<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet from the line<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> nothing on the East.

At the South line of Fifth Street the fence on the West is 26<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet,<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> the one on the East 22<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet from the line making the total width of the street 67<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet.

At the line between Quarto 10<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> 26 on the West<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> 11<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> 27 on the East, the West fence line is 24<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> the East fence line is 37<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet from the line, making the total width of the street 61<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet.

At the North line of First Street, the fence corner on the West is 20<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet,<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> stake on the East 25<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet from the line, making the total width of the street 45<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet.

At the South line of First Street, the fence on the West is 17<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> the stakes on the East is 30<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet from the line, leaving the street 50<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet width.

At the line between Quarto 40<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> 52 on the West<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> Quarto 41<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> 53 on the East, the West fence is 11<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet,<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> the pipe on the East is 36<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet from the line, making the total width of street 53<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet.

At this line back the fence on the West is 14<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> the pipe on the East is 26<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet from the line, leaving the street at this point 60<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet wide.

There is a pipe<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> stakes at the North line of Sixth Street, as stakes at the North West corner of Quarto 41<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> 52 pipe at the line between Quarto 41<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> 52,<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> as pipe at the North line of Quarto 53 on the river bank,<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> with these stakes<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> pipe there is no straight line that will even approximately agree.

You will also note on Quarto 41<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> the North line according to the "Official Map of the City of Austin" should be 60<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet; it measures 61<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet. Also, the North line should be 60<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> according to same map 60<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet; it measures 67<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> feet. Now these stakes<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> pipe were either set wrong by the B. & F. R. Company Surveyor, or noted wrong by me that recorded them,<sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> as the plot is a new one, having been filed for record less than a year ago, it seems to me that it would be in order to call on that company to furnish us with a corrected plot of the addition.

Lines Perpendiculares  
Street

Until a recouring<sup>111</sup> or corrected map of the entire portions of the Meldekins below Fifth Street is made, I do not see any way of intelligently determining on the lines of three north<sup>111</sup> South Streets.<sup>111</sup> For this reason I cannot now recommend any line for Beltrami's Street.

The center of Triches Street is fixed at 86.5 feet.

The center of Red River Street is fixed at 82 feet.

The East property line of Congress Avenue ( edge of paving ) is hereby fixed relative to the initial point above established, at 95.2 feet.

The center of Brazos street is fixed at 99..5 feet

The center of San Jacinto street is fixed at 98..5 feet.

The center of Trinity street is fixed at 97..5 feet.

All of said elevations hereinabove given are fixed relatively to the initial point of 100 feet as first stated in this resolution.
