

Regular meeting of the City Council, Austin, Texas July 1st 1909.

Hon A P Wooldridge, Mayor, presiding. Roll called :

Present Mayor Wooldridge, Councilmen Bartholomew, Gracy, Hart & Powell

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved.

Petitions, Memorials, etc:

By Councilman Hart petition of Citizens asking that liberal appropriations be made for the City Hospital. Read and ordered filed for future consideration.

By Councilman Hart petition of the Excelsior Meat Market, asking to have certain pound fees refunded. Read and on motion referred to Councilman Hart for investigation and report.

Reports of Committees:

Councilman Hart to whom was referred the petition of Jno Doehler, asking reduction of Assessment for taxes, presented a verbal report recommending that the petition be NOT granted, which report was adopted by the following vote :

Nays none.

Councilman Hart to whom was referred the petition of J E Lane, et al, to have fine assessed in Recorders Court remitted, presented a verbal report recommending that the petition be NOT granted, which recommendation was adopted by the following vote :

New Business :

By Mayor Wooldridge an ordinance setting aside 5% of the General Revenue for Public Park purposes. The ordinance was read the first time.

By Mayor Wooldridge an ordinance setting apart 2 1/2% per cent of the General Revenue of the City of Austin for Cemetery purposes .
The ordinance was read the first time .
