

Regular meeting of the City Council : Austin, Teas, May 12th 1910.

Hon A P Weeldridge, Mayor presiding: All called:

Present Mayor Weeldridge, Councilmen Gracy, Hart & Powell 4

Absent Councilman Bartholemew 1

The minutes of the last regular and recessed meetings were read and approved.

Unfinished business :

The Mayor laid before the Council an ordinance regulating place of burial within the corporate limits of the City of Austin, which was read the third time and passed by the following vote:

Absent Councilman Bartholemew 1

On motion the Council recessed.

May 15th 1910.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor, with all members present, except Councilman Bartholemew,

On motion the University Students were granted permission to fire a cannon on the University campus, /about an hour, on Monday night May 17th 1910, by the following vote:

The Mayor laid before the Council the following ordinance viz:

An ordinance regulating traffic on and across the Avenue bridge over the Colorado river at the foot of Congress Avenue, etc.

The ordinance was read the first time and the rule suspended and it placed on its second reading by the following vote :

Absent Councilman Bartholemew 1
