That twenty five hundred dollars (\$ 2,500.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Gened fund of the City of Austin for the purpose of paying the miscellaneous expenses of the City for the current year. Said appropriation of \$ 2,500. to be credited in the budget to the account of the general contingent fund.

The City to furnish all reinforcing steel and devices for connecting and spacing same at its own expense, all other material and equipment, tools, forms, labor and what ever else is necessary in the prosecution and completion of this work is to be furnished by the contractor at his expense. Approximate cost \$ 3,000

Section 1. Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Austin :

That the sum of Five Thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the General fund in the City Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying salaries of Officers and Employees of the City of Austin for the months of January and February 1911, except these included in Street, Fire, Police, Sanitary, Hospital, Park or Cemetery.
