The Council recessed subject to call of the Mayor.

January 17th 1911.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor with all members present, except Councilman Powell.

Councilman Bartholemew offered the following resolution :

Resolved that the Supt of Parks and Public Property be authorized to advertise bids for the construction of a filtering trench, according to plans and specifications prepared by Engineer M. C. Welborn from the well near the Pumping station to a distance of about ³⁰⁰ ~~400~~ feet in a westerly direction towards the I & O N R R Bridge.

The resolution was adopted by the following vote :
