

Regular meeting of the City Council : Austin, Texas, Feb'y 2nd 1911.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor : Roll called:

Present Mayor Wooldridge, Councilmen Bartholomew, Gracy, Hart & Powell 5
Absent none.

The Minutes of the last regular and subsequent recessed meeting were read and adopted by the following vote :

Yeas Mayor Wooldridge, Councilmen Bartholomew, Gracy, Hart & Powell .5

Reports of City Officers:

The Mayor laid before the Council the reports of the City Engineer and Sanitary Inspector for the months of December 1910, which were read and ordered filed.

Unfinished business :

The matter of awarding bid for Sidewalks on East 9th street was taken up, and Mr W D Hart Attorney for W B Walker and Mrs Millett addressed the Council.

Further consideration of the matter was postponed until this evening

The Mayor laid before the Council an ordinance appropriating the sum of \$ 500.00 for the purpose of purchasing two pairs of Mules for street Dept, which was read the third time and passed by the following vote :

The Mayor laid before the Council an ordinance to regulate the sale of food-stuffs within certain districts, for the violation of which a penalty is provided.

Councilman Powell offered the following resolution :

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin :

That the following grades be and the same are hereby established as the permanent grades of the center line of East 15th street from Congress Avenue to San Jacinto street. The elevations are taken from the top of the fire plug at the S E corner of Congress Avenue and 15th street; assumed elevation 100.

The ordinance was read the first time and the rule suspended and it placed on its second reading by the following vote :

The ordinance was read the second time and laid over .

The Mayor laid before the Council a proposition from the Staesman Co to compromise Judgement in the Dist Court of Travis County , for the sum of \$ 660.00.
