

Regular meeting of the City Council : Austin, Texas, March 30th 1911.

The Council was called to order by Councilman Bartholomew, Mayor Pro tem.

Roll called: Present Councilmen Bartholomew, Gracy, Hart & Powell 4

Absent Mayor Wooldridge 1

The Minutes of the last regular and subsequent recessed meetings were read, corrected and adopted.

Councilman Hart moved to remit a pound fee of \$ 1.50 charged against Ricard Lehman be remitted, which motion prevailed by the following vote :

Yeas Councilmen Bartholomew, Gracy, Hart & Powell 4

Nays none.

Councilman Hart moved that the agreement heretofore made by the City and Mr S R Evans to sprinkle such streets as may be designated by the Supt of Police and Public Safety, be ratified by the Council, which motion prevailed by the following vote :

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin :

That the City Clerk is hereby authorized to put J P Murray, Assistant to the City Engineer, on the monthly pay roll, salary at one hundred dollars (\$ 100.00) per month ; to be paid out of the General fund time commencing March 1st 1911.
