SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL:

Austin, Texas, April 9th, 1928.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor. Roll call showed the following members present: Mayor McFadden, Councilmen Mueller, Reed, and Steck, 4; absent, Councilman Pannell.

Consideration of the various bids for the construction of the new unit to the City Hospital was had, and the following bids were accepted, same being the lowest and best bids for the particular work which each proposed, and awards made accordingly:

TO H. E. WATTINGER

For general construction, in the aggregate amount of \$65,171.00, said amount being determined by omitting and changing the original bid of said H.E. Wattinger in the amount of \$69,296.00, by deducting the following items; but provided that any or all of such items may be reinstated at the prices stated for each as follows:

- (1) Lowering Pent House and Stack, as per alternate bid --\$ 750.00
- (2) Artificial Stone, in lieu of Natural Stone -----1000.00
- (3) Changing Plate Glass to D. S. Glass ----- 700.00
- (4) Reducing Parapet Walls ----- 300.00
- (5) Reducing Basement Floor thickness ----- 150.00
- (6) Omitting Picture Molding ----- 180.00
- (7) Changing Metal Frames to Wooden in Closets ----- 250.00
- (8) Reducing allowance for Weather Strips ----- 60.00
- (9) Changing Copper Wire to Pearl Wire in Screens ----- 35.00
- (10) Reducing Hardware allowance -----1000.00

making a total deduction of \$4,425.00, and adding for gravel roof, \$300.00, making the net bid read-----\$65,171.00

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL:

Austin, Texas, April 12th, 1928.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor. Roll call showed the following members present: Mayor McFadden, Councilmen Mueller, Pannell, Reed, and Steck, 5; absent, none.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and Councilman Mueller moved the adoption of same. Motion was seconded by Councilman Steck and same prevailed by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor McFadden, Councilmen Mueller, Pannell, Reed, and Steck, 5; nays, none.

A. W. Seekatz appeared before the Council and asked that 29th Street and West Avenue be included in the proposed paving program for the City. The Council thanked Mr. Seekatz for his interest in street improvement and expressed their approval of the proposition if it is found practicable to do so.

A communication from George S. Nalle, asking for an adjustment of the taxes on Lots 3 to 8, Block 129, was read, and the Council instructed that a resolution be drawn, granting the relief asked for, and presented for adoption at the next regular meeting.

The application of T. M. Baker for license to operate a service car was heard. The Council postponed action on the matter until further investigation could be made.

Mayor McFadden moved that the account of H. F. Kuehne, for the sum of \$2748.81, same being 3% commission for plans and specifications for new unit to the City Hospital, be approved and ordered paid. Motion was seconded by Councilman Mueller and same prevailed by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor McFadden, Councilmen Mueller, Pannell, Reed, and Steck, 5; nays, none.

Mayor McFadden laid before the Council the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

THAT the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the City of Austin in payment of the amount due and
