That the Superintendent of Streets and Public Improvements of the City of Austin, Texas, be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to contract with the Finley Method Company to tarviate with trap rock 7/8" in size for covering material and 7/10 gallons of tervia per square yard as Bitumen, State or 34th Street from where it intersects Guadalupe Street to the city limits in the direction of Camp Mabry. The price to be paid for said work is to be 26% per square yard for original treatment and 740 per square yard for each re-treatment.

The resolution was adopted by the following vote: Yeas--Mayor Wooldridge, Councilmen Anthony, Bartholomew, Haynes, and Powell, 5; nays none.
