Mayor Wooldridge effored the following resolution :

That whereas the bend money of the Sanitary sewer fund being exhausted, the City Treasurer be and is hereby instructed from this dage to place all interest on daily balances of the Sanitary sewer fund to the credit of said fund instead of to the credit of the Interest and sinking fund as heretofore.

October 24th 1917b

Mayor Weoldridge offered the following resolution :

Whereas, on March 1st of the present yearthe money derived from the sale of Sanitary sewer bonds wasexhausted: and

Whereas, all monies placed to the credit of the Sanitary sewer fund since that date crose from other than the proceeds from the sale of bonds, but

Whereas the interest paid by the bank depository on said funds arising from the credits of the sanitary sewer fund, through error, having continued to be placed to the credit of the Interest and Sinking fund instead of the sanitary sewer fund; and

Whereas ,said interest from March 1 st to October 1st,1917, amounted to the sum of two hundred and four dollars and twenty eight censs (\$ 204.28)

Now therefore,

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin, Texas :

That the sum of two hundred and four dollars and twenty eight cents (\$ 204.28) be and the same is hereby transferred from the Interest and Sinking fund to the sanitary sewer fund, and the City Treasurer and the book-keeper of the sanitary sewer fund be and they are hereby instructed to make entries upon their books in accordance with the terms of this resolution.
