SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL:

Austin Texas, December 14, 1931.

The Council met at 7:30 P. M. for the purpose of considering the various tax appeals of property owners submitted to the Council at its meeting on the 9th ultimo. Roll call showed the following members present: Councilmen Alford, Gillis, Mayor McFadden, Councilmen Mueller and Steck, 5; absent, none.

Mayor McFadden moved that E. M. Scarbrough & Sons be given a credit of \$34,815.00 on their assessment for the year 1931 against the old store building located on the west 16 feet of Lot 3, all of Lot 4, and the south 40 feet of Lot 5, Block 55, Original City, which has been torn down, but that no change be made in the assessed valuation on other improvements belonging to the said E. M. Scarbrough & Sons, and that the Assessor and Collector of Taxes be instructed to change his rolls accordingly.
