AND THAT whenever pavement is cut in the vicinity of a fire plug, water must be used at intervals during the course of backfilling of the ditches.

THAT the work and laying of said gas mains, including the excavation in the streets and the restoration and maintenance of said streets after said mains have been laid, shall be under the supervision and direction of the City Manager, and under all the pertinent terms and conditions of the certain franchise granted to said company by the City of Austin.

The above resolution was adopted by the following vote: Ayes, Councilmen Alford, Gillis, Mayor MoFadden. Councilmen Mueller, 4; nays, none; Councilmen Steck absent, 1.

A petition signed by V. B. Keith and other property owners on West 29th Street, protesting the recent change in the name of this street to "Mocking Bird Lane", was read and referred to the City Plan Commission for consideration.

The Mayor laid before the Council the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:
