A.O. Watson appeared before the Council in connection with the curbing at the S.W. Corner of West 6th and Lavaca Streets.

Councilman Ward moved that the matter be referred to Councilman Graham with full power to act in the premises.

Motion was adopted by the following vote Mayor Yett, Councilmen Alford, Graham, Haynes and Ward.

W.L. Ayres appeared and asked permission to put in curbing at his place of business situated at the corner of West 6th and Lavaca Streets.
