REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL:

Austin, Texas, March 24, 1921.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor. Roll call showed the following members present: Mayor Yett, Councilmen Alford, Graham, Haynes and Ward, 5; absent, none.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and upon motion of Councilman Ward were adopted by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Alford, Graham, Haynes and Ward, 5; naves, none.

Councilman Haynes moved that the regular order of business be suspended and that a committee be heard. Motion prevailed by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Alford, Graham, Haynes and Ward, 5; naves, none.

A committee composed of S. A. Glaser, et al., representing the Municipal Band, appeared before the Council and asked permission to use Protection Fire Hall for rehearsals. Councilman Haynes moved that said Municipal Band be allowed the use of Protection Hall for rehearsals during such days of the week as desired for the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per month, subject to revocation. Motion prevailed by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Alford, Graham, Haynes and Ward, 5; naves, none.

Councilman Graham introduced the following resolution:

"Whereas, the City of Austin heretofore purchased certain gravel on Lots Nos. 1 and 2 in Block No. 3, Outlet No. 42, Division "B" of the City of Austin from C. E. Straub, who was at said time the owner of said lots; and

"Whereas, at the time that said city took said gravel from said lots, D. J. Pickle was the holder and owner of a vendor's lien against same; and

"Whereas, said Pickle has since said time been compelled to foreclose his lien and to take possession of said lots, which had been impaired in value by the act of the city in taking gravel therefrom as aforesaid; and

"Whereas, it is proper and just to compensate said Pickle for said damages, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

That the sum of One Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General Street Fund of the City of Austin for the purpose of paying said Pickle, and the City Clerk is hereby

instructed to issue a warrant payable to the said Pickle for said amount; and in further and full settlement for said damages, the City of Austin agrees to level off and fill said lots to a general level as same now exists.

The above resolution was adopted by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Alford, Graham, Haynes and Ward, 5; nays, none.

Councilman Haynes introduced the Bill of Costs of the District Clerk, amounting to \$393.15, accrued in certain tax suits against certain insurance companies. Upon motion of Councilman Ward, the same was adopted by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Alford, Graham, Haynes and Ward, 5; nays, none.

The application of Jno. Barber to operate a service car, Ford #599525 was granted by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Alford, Graham, Haynes and Ward, 5; nays, none.

The following report of the City Clerk was read and ordered filed:
