SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL:

Austin, Texas, January 9, 1929.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor. Roll call showed the following members present: Mayor McFadden, Councilmen Mueller, Pannell, Reed, and Steck, 5; absent, none.

Councilman Pannell moved that, based upon the report submitted by the U.G.I. Contracting Company, the City of Austin, acting by and through its City Manager, enter into a contract with said firm for the installation of a new unit to the City's power plant, such contract to be satisfactory to the City Attorney and City Manager; and that the City Attorney be directed to prepare a resolution covering the matter and submit same to the City Council. Motion was seconded by Councilman Mueller, and same prevailed by the following vote: Mayor McFadden, Councilmen Mueller, Pannell, and Steck, 4; nays, Councilman Reed, who stated that he voted nay for the reason that such action is contrary to his best judgment, but that since a majority of the City Council have voted in favor of same, he will co-operate in every way toward the success of the project.
