REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL:

Austin, Texas, August 24, 1922.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor. Roll call showed the following members present: Mayor Yett, Councilmen Copeland, and Haynes; 3, absent, Councilmen Eyres and Searight.

The Minutes of the last meeting were read and upon motion of Councilman Haynes were adopted by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Copeland and Haynes, 3; naves, none, Councilmen Eyres and Searight absent.

Harvey Harrell and others, composing a committee from the Chamber of Commerce, appeared before the Council and asked that the Central Texas Fair Association be granted the use of East Avenue from Sixth Street north to Eleventh Street for the purpose of holding a carnival by the Wortham Shows. The same was granted by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Copeland and Haynes, 3; naves, none, absent, Councilmen Eyres and Searight.

The application of W. H. Williams, Agent of the Gulf Refining Company, for permission to erect an electric sign at #109 Congress Avenue, upon motion of Councilman Haynes was referred to the Safety Committee, by the following vote: Ayes, Mayor Yett, Councilmen Copeland and Haynes, 3; naves, none, Councilmen Eyres and Searight absent.
