

Austin City Council MINUTES

For SPECIAL CALLED MEETING - AUGUST 18, 1987 - 3:00 P.M. FOURTH FLOOR AUDITORIUM - CENTRAL LIBRARY

Memorandum To:

Mayor Cooksey called to order the special called meeting of the Council, noting the absence of Council-members Shipman and Urdy; and Mayor Pro Tem Trevino.

Mayor Cooksey announced the first item would be a presentation of Aviation Issues, specifically, long term development options for Robert Mueller Airport.

Tim Ward, Director of the Airport, discussed the alternatives and said the cost is high.

Rick Wheeler, assistant project director, Greiner*
Austin Team, showed slides depicting the options. He said they are recommending Option C4-C, and compared it to other options. Mr. Ward told Council all airlines have been involved in the discussions from the beginning.
