CITY MANAGER REPORTS

Town Lake Master Plan report was presented by Mr. Jordan and staff members of PARD by means of a slide presentation.

Libby Watson gave the <u>Community Education</u> report. Discussion of overlapping of <u>community</u> schools and recreation center classes was held. Mayor Pro Tem Trevino said Council faces this dilemma every year and the support may not be as strong this year. He said the City may do community recreation and let AISD do community education.

Paula Phillips discussed <u>McKinney Meadows</u> with a review of the land use plan.
