Memorandum To:

Mayor Cooksey called to order the special called meeting, set for 9:00 a.m. at 2:10 p.m. The Mayor noted the presence of all Councilmembers except Councilmember Urdy, who arrived at 3:40 p.m.

COMMUNITY ADVOCATE FOR TEENS AND PARENTS

ELECTRIC UTILITY COMMISSION

Albert Fairweather, Chairman, Electric Utility Commission, reported to Council concerning their recent meeting and budget recommendations.

BUDGET WORKSESSION

Mayor Cooksey announced the Council would hold a budget worksession. He asked Jim Thompson, Director of Water and Wastewater to present his department's report. After the report, Mayor Cooksey asked the department heads present to go over the list of suggested personnel deletions and justify any which they thought were unjustified.
