ORDINANCE NO. 20051201-018

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF REAL PROPERTY FROM THE CITY TO THE AUSTIN REVITALIZATION AUTHORITY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF LOW-INCOME OR MODERATE-INCOME HOUSING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council finds that:

- (1) The historical structure and the property located at 1108 Olive Street, as described in Exhibit A (Affordable Housing Tract) was acquired by the City other than by condemnation. Exhibit A is incorporated as part of this ordinance.
- (2) The transfer of the historical structure and the Affordable Housing Tract (Property) to the Austin Revitalization Authority (ARA) for the development of low-income or moderate-income housing furthers the goals and policies of the City and serves a public purpose under Texas Local Government Code Section 272.001(g).
- PART 2. The City Manager may transfer the Property at less than its fair market value to ARA to develop low-income or moderate-income housing.
- PART 3. The City Manager may enter into and execute any written document required to implement this ordinance, including a transfer agreement or deed.

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PART 4. This ordinance takes effect on December 12, 2005.
