ORDINANCE NO. 20060112-058

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 25-10-6 OF THE CITY CODE TO ADD STATE HIGHWAY 130 AS A SCENIC ROADWAY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 25-10-6 (Scenic Roadways Described) of the City Code is amended to read:

§ 25-10-6 SCENIC ROADWAYS DESCRIBED.

The following are scenic roadways:

- (1) Arterial 8 (Adelaide Drive/Forsythia Drive);
- (2) Barton Springs Road;
- (3) Loop 1 (MoPac);
- (4) Loop 360 (Capital of Texas Highway), south of US 183;
- (5) RM 620, from SH 71 to Anderson Mill Road (FM 2769);
- (6) RM 2222, west of MoPac only;
- (7) RM 2244;
- (8) Lake Austin Boulevard;
- (9) West Cesar Chavez Street;
- (10) Riverside Drive;
- (11) Spicewood Springs Road, from Mesa Drive to Loop 360;
- (12) William Cannon Drive, from Brodie Lane to Southwest Parkway;
- (13) Escarpment Boulevard, from William Cannon Drive to Arterial 11 (SH 45);
- (14) Arterial 5 (McKinney Falls Parkway) from US 183 to William Cannon Drive;

(15) FM 973 from SH 71 to US	183;
(16) SH 71 east of IH-35;	
(17) US 183 south of SH 71;	
(18) Cameron Road, north of US 183;	
(19) Parmer Lane, except for the area between Loop 1 (Mopac) and IH 35;	
(20) Stassney Lane, east of IH 3	5;
(21) Slaughter Lane; [and]	
(22) Old Spicewood Springs Ro	ad, from Loop 360 to Old Lampasas Trail; and
(23) SH 130.
