

ORDINANCE NO. 20060202-016

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE PRESIDING JUDGE, ASSOCIATE JUDGES INCLUDING THE DOWNTOWN AUSTIN COMMUNITY COURT JUDGE, AND SUBSTITUTE JUDGES OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN MUNICIPAL COURT; AND ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The City Council appoints Evelyn McKee as the Presiding Judge of the Municipal Court for the term beginning January 1, 2006, and ending December 31, 2007.

PART 2. The City Council appoints the following people as Associate Judges of the Municipal Court for the term beginning January 1, 2006, and ending December 31, 2007:

PART 3. The City Council appoints Associate Judge Michael Coffey to serve as the judge of the Downtown Austin Community Court.

PART 4. The City Council appoints the following people as Substitute Judges for the Municipal Court for the term beginning January 1, 2006, and ending December 31, 2007:

PART 5. The City Council does not appoint to the Municipal Court the term beginning January 1, 2006, and ending December 31, 2007, any person not specifically named in this ordinance.

PART 6. Compensation for the Presiding Judge is \$3972.00 per pay period.

PART 7. Compensation for an Associate Judge, including the Downtown Austin Community Court Judge, is \$3239.20 per pay period.

PART 8. Compensation for a Substitute Judge is \$38.13 per hour.

PART 9. The Presiding Judge and Associate Judges, including the Downtown Austin Community Court Judge, shall receive the following benefits:

- (A) participation in the Employees' Retirement System;
- (B) leave accruals and benefits at the same levels and rates provided for regular full-time City employees;
- (C) if eligible, service incentive pay in the same amount and under the same conditions as non-Civil Service employees.

PART 10. A substitute judge shall serve only as scheduled by the presiding judge, and is not eligible for City benefits or compensation except as provided for in Part 8 of this ordinance. Part 9 of this ordinance does not apply to a substitute judge.

PART 11. The terms "sick leave," "vacation," and "holidays" have the same meaning given to those terms in the City of Austin Personnel Policies for Non-Civil Service Employees.

PART 12. This ordinance takes effect on February 19, 2006.


