## **ORDINANCE NO. 20060209-003**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 2-2-34(B) OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO THE DUTIES OF THE CITY CLERK, AND SUBSECTION 2-7-31(D) OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO AN ETHICS COMMISSION OMBUDSMAN.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

**PART 1.** Subsection 2-2-34(B) of the Code is amended to read:

## § 2-2-34 FUNDING FOR QUALIFYING CANDIDATES.

- (B) Priority for distribution of funds. Funding from the Austin Fair Campaign Finance Fund shall be distributed to qualifying candidates in a runoff election under [pursuant to] the following procedure and formula:
  - (1) <u>Upon request, the [The]</u>city clerk shall <u>state</u> [certify to the Council and <u>Ethics Review Commission</u>] the available balance in the Austin Fair Campaign Finance Fund [on the first day for filing for a place on the ballot and ten days before the election];
  - (2) Funds for a city runoff election shall be made available as soon as practicable after the results of the city general election are certified; and
  - (3) The City Clerk shall review the "30-day" and "8-day" before election contribution and expenditure reports and any supporting materials filed by qualifying candidates seeking public funds to verify compliance with the expenditure limits of the candidate's campaign contract.

PART 1. Subsection 2-7-31(D) of the Code is amended to read:

## § 2-7-31 STAFFING.

(D) The city clerk shall make the reporting and complaint forms and information developed by the Commission available to the public and shall assist citizens in complying with filing [assign an ombudsman to, among other duties, provide the public with information developed by the Commission regarding this chapter and assist citizens in compliance with the] procedures [set forth in this chapter].

PART 2. This ordinance takes effect on February 20, 2006.
