

**RESOLUTION NO. 20060323-012**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Austin to authorize the application for and acceptance of \$25,583 in grant renewal funding from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant Program (JAIBG), to continue enforcement of juvenile Class C Misdemeanor offenses and to contract with La FUENTE for a juvenile diversion program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has considered the proposed application for and acceptance of grant renewal funds for said project, in the amount of \$25,583 from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant Program (JAIBG), to continue enforcement of juvenile Class C Misdemeanor offenses and to contract with La FUENTE for a juvenile diversion program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is committed to providing for the applicable matching funds as required; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council designates the Assistant City Manager for public safety as the authorized official who has the power to apply for, accept, reject, agree to alter or terminate this grant; and


