

RESOLUTION NO. 20060420-019

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Austin, to authorize the application for and acceptance of \$10,625 in fifth year grant funding from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Safe and Drug Free Schools and Communities Act Fund for the renewal of the Austin Police Department project entitled "Austin Faith Community Network" to increase youth after-school activities and mentoring; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the proposed application for and acceptance of State grant funds for said project, in the amount of \$10,625 from the State of Texas, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, Safe and Drug Free School and Communities Act Fund for the renewal of the Austin Police Department project entitled "Austin Faith Community Network"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is committed to providing for the applicable matching funds as required; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Assistant City Manager for Public Safety as the authorized official who has the power to apply for, accept, reject, agree to alter or terminate this grant; and


