ORDINANCE NO. 20060420-057

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14-8-13 OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE FOR A STREET EVENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 14-8-13 of the City Code is amended to read:

§ 14-8-13 APPLICATION DEADLINES.

- (A) Except as provided in Subsection (D), an [An] applicant must file an application to close an arterial street with the director not later than the 60th day before the date of the proposed street event.
- (B) Except as provided in Subsection (D), an [An] applicant must file an application to close a neighborhood collector or residential street with the director not later than the 45th day before the date of the proposed closure.
- (C) The director may waive the deadlines established in this section at the director's discretion.
- (D) This subsection applies to an annual event that has been held for 10 or more years in the area bounded on the north by Eleventh Street, on the east by IH-35, on the south by Cesar Chavez Street and on the west by Guadalupe Street.
 - (1) An application filed by the event's sponsor not later than the 30th day after the last day of the current year's event has priority over other applications. If the application complies with this chapter, the director shall approve the application
 - (2) Not less frequently than every two years, the director shall present Council with a report listing the events that received permits under this subsection and recommending repeal or continuation of this subsection.

PART 2. This ordinance takes effect on May 1, 2006. PASSED AND APPROVED
