Proposal:

Original items

- Masonry Fence (six foot) along the western boundary of the property except for where there exists a masonry fence and along Peaceful Hill Road.
- > Cedar fence (eight foot) along the eastern boundary of the property until the pond area.
- > Prohibit vehicular access to Peaceful Hill Road but provide a pedestrian access.
- Lots along the western boundary (except along Peaceful Hill) make them 150-160' deep.
- ▶ Lots along the eastern boundary make them 125-130' in depth.
- Lots along the north side of the Crippen sheet-metal property make 125-130' in depth.

Additional items

- Restrict the entire property through a restrictive covenant that runs with the land which specifically notifies all owners of adjacent commercial/industrial uses and bars complaints against lawful activity on the commercial tracts.
- Restricting the lots to single-story homes adjacent to the Crippen sheet metal.
- Extra insulation in homes for noise abatement.



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
