**ORDINANCE NO.**

**AN ORDINANCE ORDERING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF AUSTIN ON MAY 13, 2006, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING A PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT TO THE VOTERS; AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** A charter amendment election shall be held in the City on May 13, 2006, at which the ballot shall be prepared to permit voting "yes" or "no" on the following proposition:

**Proposition 1**

Shall the City Charter be amended to restore a city employee's ability to purchase additional benefit coverage, by repealing Article IX, Section 4 (*Employee Benefits*) of the City Charter?

**PART 2.** The election shall be conducted as provided in Ordinance No. 2006 \_\_\_\_\_. The provisions of Ordinance No. 2006 \_\_\_\_\_ relating to the conduct of the election are incorporated by reference as part of this ordinance.

**PART 3.** If Proposition 1 is approved by the majority of the voters voting at the election, Article IX, Section 4 of the City Charter, as added by the election of May 7, 1994, is repealed.

**PART 4.** This ordinance takes effect on \_\_\_\_\_, 2006.
