Conducted AARC "Needs Survey" in Asian Community to identify AARC needs and priorities


NAAD formed the AARC Committee to act as liaison between City of Austin and Asian community

History of the NAAO

The Network of Asian American Organizations (NAAO) was established in 1996 and officially incorporated as a nonprofit organization in 1999. NAAO is to unite Asian-American organizations of common interest, and to achieve their common objectives.

As of March 17, 2004, NAAO includes the following (thirteen) (13) group member Organizations: Asian American Employee Network, Asian Construction Trades Association, Asian American Chamber of Commerce, Austin Hill Country American Association, Austin Taiwanese Association, SAHPI for Asian Families, Cambodian Foundation, Chinese Society of Austin, India Community Center, Vietnamese American Community of Austin Texas, Pakistani American Association of Greater Austin, Korean Community of Austin, Sri Lankan Community of Austin and Banglaदेश Community of Austin.

History of the AARC

AARC has been the vision of Asian American leaders and the Asian community in Austin metropolitan area since 1998. To find out the needs of the community, AARC Sub Committee of the NAAO conducted a "Need Survey" in Year 2002 and its findings became the basis of the AARC project.

NAAO successfully worked with the City of Austin to pass a City Ordinance in May 2003 to establish the Asian American Resource Center Advisory Board as an entity to bring forward the public opinions of this project.

City of Austin has been very supportive of the AARC project. The community has the understanding that the City will provide the land for this project.




Vision Statement


Mission Statement
