ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS IN CHAPTERS 14-8 AND 25-10 OF THE CITY CODE, CERTAIN FEES AND CHARGES, AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF CERTAIN COSTS FOR THE GREATER EAST AUSTIN YOUTH ASSOCIATION'S 2006 JUNETEENTH PARADE AND FESTIVAL TO BE HELD JUNE 15 - 17, 2006.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council waives the requirements in City Code Sections 14-8-12 (*Security Deposit Required*), 14-8-16 (*Notice of Proposed Closure and Signature Requirement*), and 14-8-17 (*Calculation of Required Signatures; Request for Reduction*) for the Greater East Austin Youth Association's 2006 Juneteenth Festival and Parade to be held June 15 - 17, 2006.

PART 2. The Council waives the requirements in City Code Section 25-10-172 (*Restrictions*) limiting the number of banners allowed for advertising an event per year.

PART 3. The Council waives the following fees and charges in connection with the Greater East Austin Youth Association's 2006 Juneteenth Parade and Festival. Fees that have been paid shall be reimbursed.
