This action approves an ordinance to establish the classifications and number of positions in the classified service of the Police Department and repeals Ordinance No. 20050912-006. This action increases the number of Sergeant positions by 1 and decreases the number of Police Officer positions by 1.

A Police Sergeant is needed in patrol for Patrol supervisory duties in the South Central Area Command. The Police Sergeant will be responsible for supervising, coordinating, and assigning the activities of shift of police officers or investigators and respond to emergency situations.

Within the Austin Police Department, Civil Service classifications and the number of positions is as follows:

**ORDINANCE NO. 20060112-**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CLASSIFICATIONS AND POSITIONS IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 20050912-006.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1.** The council makes the following findings:

- (A) The City adopted Texas Local Government Code Chapter 143, which applies to members of the classified service in the Police Department.
- (B) Chapter 143 provides that the city council shall establish the classifications for the Police Department and the number of positions in each classification.
- (C) The Police Department recommends the creation and reduction of certain classified positions to improve the delivery of police services and increase efficiency in the Police Department.

**PART 2.** The following civil service classifications of the Police Department and the number of positions in each classification are established as follows:

| (D) Police Sergeant   | 149 |
| (E) Police Detective  | 274 |

**PART 3.** The number of positions in the classification of Police Sergeant in Part 2 of this ordinance is an increase of one from the number in existence immediately before the effective date of this ordinance.
