SUBJECT: Authorize execution of Amendment No. 7 to the service agreement with ASAP ELECTRIC, INC., Austin, TX, for the installation of water heater timers, to increase the second extension option in an amount not to exceed \$140,969, for a revised total agreement not to exceed \$628,467.

MBE / WBE: This contract was awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

In June 2003, Council approved a 12-month service agreement with two 12-month extension options, with ASAP Electric, Inc., for the installation of load control devices (energy control timers) for multifamily dwellings. These water heater timers are part of the Austin Energy Load Management Program -Cycle Saver. The agreement also provides recruitment into the program, scheduling, problem solving, and removal from the program.

This action authorizes Amendment No. 7 to provide installation of an additional 1800 water heater timers. These additional timers are needed to help Austin Energy's efforts to reach the conservation goals as stated in the ten-year AE Strategic Plan approved by the City Council. AE's Fiscal Year 2005-2006 approved operating budget included increased installation rates of water heater timers for the Load Management Program - Cycle Saver.
