<u>SUBJECT:</u> Authorize execution of a construction contract with AARON CONCRETE CONTRACTORS, LP (MBE/MH 41.38%), Austin, TX, for the street rehabilitation of Middle Fiskville Road and Northcrest Boulevard in the amount of \$1,432,726.30 plus a \$71,636.32 contingency, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,504,362.62.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING</u>: Funding in the amount of \$1,429,865.12 is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Amended Capital Budget of the Public Works Department and funding in the amount of \$74,497.50 is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Capital Budget of the Austin Water Utility.

<u>PRIOR COUNCIL ACTION</u>: This project was approved by Council on July 28, 2005. The project was subsequently re-bid due to unreported SBC conflicts.

BOARD AND COMMISSION ACTION: N/A

<u>PURCHASING</u>: Lower bid of two received.

MBE / WBE: 4.99% MBE and 49.13% WBE subcontractor participation.

This project consists of street rehabilitation for both Middle Fiskville Road (Koenig Lane to Highland Mall Boulevard) and Northcrest Boulevard (Crestland Drive to Prince Drive). Middle Fiskville includes 1,887 linear feet of roadway rehabilitation; approximately half of this is full depth pavement reconstruction and the other half is overlay with extra depth pavement repair on the outer lanes. The work on Middle Fiskville includes lowering three SBC lines, bus pad replacement and replacing portions of curb and gutter and driveway. New sidewalk and ramps provide an accessible path to the Greyhound Bus station. Northcrest Boulevard includes full and partial depth pavement reconstruction of 1,325 linear feet of roadway. Sidewalk ramps are also replaced to meet current ADA standards.

Due to the potential for unknown subsurface conditions and utility conflicts when working in the right-ofway, a 5% contingency in funding has been included to allow for the expeditious processing of any future change orders. The contract allows 210 calendar days for completion of this project.

Bid documents were distributed to seven general contractors. Bids were opened on December 15, 2005. Aaron Concrete Contractors, LP submitted the lower of two bids received:

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


The contractor's choice of work methodology provides for subcontracting opportunities in nine areas: photography, trucking, electric manhole adjustment, excavation, wastewater manhole adjustment, erosion control, sodding, traffic barricades and striping. Project specific subgoals stated in the solicitation were 2.28% African American (MB); 9.82% Hispanic (MH); 0% Native American (MN); 0.26% Asian Americans (MA); 8.57% WBE.
