CONTRACTORS.

<u>SUBJECT:</u> Authorize execution of a 12-month service agreement with AUSTIN DRIVE TRAIN, Austin, TX, for vehicle rear differential repair services in an amount not to exceed \$150,000, with three 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 per extension option, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$600,000.

<u>AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING</u>: Funding in the amount of \$100,000 is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Approved Operating Budget of the Fleet Maintenance Fund of the Finance and Administrative Services Department. Funding for the remaining four months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

FISCAL NOTE: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

PURCHASING: Lowest responsive bid of two bids received.

<u>MBE / WBE</u>: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This service agreement is for rear differential repair services for various light, medium, and heavy duty vehicles including but not limited to pickups, utility vehicles, and dump trucks for the City's Fleet Services. The vendor will provide parts and labor in order to provide these services to the City on an as needed basis. These services will supplement the City's vehicle service operations and increase responsiveness to City departments. The vehicles will be repaired within two working days of notification from the City. The City will be responsible for transporting vehicles to and from the vendor premises. This contract provides the automotive and equipment fleet service centers with a reliable and continuous source for repair services.
