SUBJECT: Authorize execution of a 12-month service agreement with N-LINE TRAFFIC MAINTENANCE (WBE-FR-100%), Austin, TX, for the rental of temporary traffic control devices for the Austin Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$83,868, with two 12-month extension options in an amount not to exceed \$83,868 per extension option, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$251,604.

AMOUNT & SOURCE OF FUNDING: Funding in the amount of \$48,923 is available in the Fiscal Year 2005-2006 Approved Operating Budget of the Austin Police Department. Funding for the remaining five months of the original contract period and the extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

FISCAL NOTE: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

MBE / WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9 of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract will provide for the rental of temporary traffic control devices (TTCD) for special events held in downtown Austin. The events include Halloween, Mardi Gras, Texas Relays, New Years Eve, Congress Avenue closures, and emergency street closures. The contractor will furnish, deliver, place, maintain, and remove TTCDs as requested by the Austin Police Department Special Events Unit. The types of TTCD provided include barricades, plastic drums, traffic cones, signs with stands, arrow boards, electronic message boards, concrete barriers, and water filled barriers.
